INTERNATIONAL TUBERCULOSIS CONCLAVE 2023

International Tuberculosis Conference on “Accelerating Progress Towards a TB-Free World: Innovation, Challenge & Solutions”

Tuberculosis (TB) is a communicable disease which is a major cause of ill health and one of the leading causes of death worldwide. Until the COVID-19 pandemic, TB was the leading cause of death from a single infectious agent, ranking above HIV/AIDS. The number of people acquiring infection and developing disease (and in turn the number of deaths caused by TB) can be reduced through multisectoral action to address TB determinants such as poverty, undernourishment, HIV infection, smoking, and diabetes. The goal of this conference is to bring together experts from around the world to share information and best practices on preventive, diagnostic, and therapeutic advances in TB. The conference will also discuss challenges and successes in TB control, identify new research priorities and strategies, and provide a forum for policymakers and advocates to discuss how to accelerate ‘End TB’ efforts globally.

Pre-conference workshop: 22nd November 2023

Five parallel pre-conference workshops are organized on 22nd November 2023

A series of hands-on sessions on the focussed thematic areas with lab/community visits will be the highlights of the workshops.

The maximum permissible registrations for each workshop is 45 (for three workshops, for other two workshops no limit in number of registrations). The delegate should select the workshop he/ she would like to participate in the registration portal itself. The entry to the workshop is purely on a first come first serve basis. Each registered delegate should stick on to the same workshop and no swapping/change after registration is allowed.

The participants are allowed to register for choice of their workshop without registering for conference.

Workshop 1. Operational Research (OR) in TB

Sessions by experts in Operational Research in TB, followed by hands on training in developing the research proposal. For this workshop the attendees must come with a concept proposal in the area of tuberculosis.

Workshop 2. Digital Health & AI in TB

In this workshop the introductory sessions on digital health & AI and its role in Tuberculosis will be dealt by the experts. The various opportunities and ongoing projects will be discussed. The participants must come with Digital or AI solutions in the area of Tuberculosis, and the experts will help in refining, modifying the concept and making it proposal.

Workshop 3. Diagnosis of TB in various scenario

Diagnosis of TB in different scenarios like paediatric TB, drug resistant TB, Extra-pulmonary TB, etc. from the point of identifying presumptive symptoms, identifying clinical findings, radiological findings, sample collection for laboratory investigation, sample transportation, laboratory investigations, etc will be discussed by the expert clinicians, microbiologists and radiologists.

Workshop 4. Airborne infection control in health care facilities

The workshop helps in develop expertise in participants on the principles of airborne infection control in health care facilities and demonstrate the application of these principles in practical situations, developing skills of facility risk assessment for airborne infection control measures will be dealt. This workshop is conducted in hybrid mode, there is no limit for number of registrations in this workshop.

Workshop 5. Quality Improvement in TB care.

The quality improvement using PDSA model will be explained and hands on exercises of application of the same in the NTEP programme will be covered. There is no limit for number of registrations in this workshop. This workshop is conducted in hybrid mode, there is no limit for number of registrations in this workshop.

Guidelines for abstract submission:

- The abstract related to sub-themes of the conference should be typed in Times New Roman Font 12 with 1.5 line spacing.
- Title, Author(s) Name(s), Designation and Affiliation, Email id of the presenting author should be mentioned below the title at the beginning of the abstract.
- The title of the abstract should be bold and in capital letters, center-aligned. Do not use Abbreviations in the title. Restrict the words in title to 25

The First Letter of the author(s) name(s) must be a Capital letter. The presenting author's name should be bold and underlined.

- Use the superscripts to indicate the designation and affiliated institutions.
- The structure of the abstract must include, Background, Aim/Objective, Methods & Materials, Results & Conclusion.
- List the most relevant 3-5 Keywords. Type them in italics, Times New Roman Font size of 12.
- The abstract should not exceed 350 words excluding the Title, Name(s) of the author(s), and Affiliations, Keywords. It must be Justified text (Align text evenly between margins).

Note:

- The presenting author must send the declaration stating that they are submitting an original

- research paper that was not published earlier or/and not submitted for publication.
- Registration is a must for the presenting author. If presenting author is a student or Research scholar, enclose the declaration certified by the Head of the Institution.
- Mention the desirous mode of presentation (Oral/Poster) of your research paper. For the oral presentation, the best papers will be selected through blind review. The acceptance for the paper presentation will be informed within 7 days. Review-based studies will not be considered for oral presentation

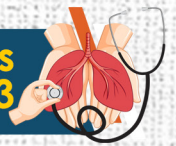

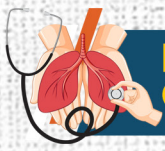
- I. Option of attending conference online is available for people registering as foreign delegates. Foreign delegates who choose to attend online

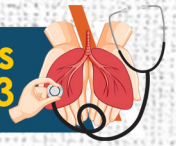

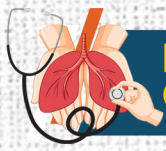
